Current Situati	on	<b>Dixie Fire West Zone</b> Fire activity continued well into the night with moderate rates of spread due to extremely dry fuels. A smoke inversion settled last night allowing for firefighters to construct direct line construction and improve existing control lines. Damage assessment is ongoing, the amount of damaged and destroyed structures may change as teams are able to access the fire area safely.8 Triple digit temperatures will continue over the next few days. Evacuation Warnings and Evacuation Orders could change every day, please see below for information affecting your area. California historically experiences some of the most devastating wildfires. 	<b>Dixie Fire East Zone:</b> Crews are focusing on structural protection to mitigate the threat to homes on Keddie Ridge and in Wilcox Valley. Fire activity increased around North Arm Road due to the thunderstorms. Additional priorities for line construction and improvement continue to support protection of the Janesville area. Outflow winds from thunderstorm cells created conditions that pushed the fire within the footprint of the 2007 Moonlight Fire. Saturday remains a high-risk fire environment due to lingering thunderstorms and possible ground lightning strikes.
